Western Boone Junior-Senior High School Principal - Mr. Brent Miller

Mr. Miller is a 1988 graduate of Western Boone. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Education from IUPUI in 1993 and a Masters in Educational Leadership from IUPUI in 2009.
