EDUCATION & OPERATION FUND COMPARISON REPORT

As of October 31, 2021, the Education Fund cash balance was \$4,180,044. The Education Fund expenditures for October 2021 were \$1,111,297. As of the end of October 2021, a total of 74% of the 2021 appropriation was expended.

As of October 31, 2021, the Operation Fund cash balance was \$1,004,666. The Operation Fund expenditures for October 2021 were \$522,900. As of the end of October 2021, a total of 65% of the 2021 appropriation was expended.
