Scenario 5:

It is Wednesday. Layla is in the 5th grade. She comes to the office after lunch with a sore throat and headache.

Layla has two sisters in other grades at the school.

You call her mother who denies Layla having any close contacts or potential exposures.

What do you do?



What do you do if Layla's parents decide to not get her tested or seen by a doctor?

- Close Contact
- Symptoms

None Test

- Layla needs to stay home for 10 days and 24 hours fever free without the use of fever reducing medication and improvement of her symptoms.
- Layla's siblings do not need to go home since Layla is not considered high risk (no contacts, no fever, no loss of taste or smell.)
- Ask Layla's parents to monitor her siblings closely for symptoms.
- School does not need to contact trace



What do you do if Layla tests negative?

- Close Contact
- Symptoms

Negative Test

- Layla can return to school with improvement of her symptoms.
- If she had developed a fever she needs to stay home until 24 hours fever free without the use of fever reducing medication.
- Siblings do not need to quarantine.
- School does not need to contact trace in the school.



What do you do if Layla tests positive?

- Close Contact
- Symptoms

Positive Test

- Layla should isolate at home for 10 days and 24 hours fever free without the use of fever-reducing medication and improvement of symptoms.
- Siblings need to quarantine for 14 days after their last exposure to Layla. If they are unable to separate in the home this would be 14 days after Layla finished her 10-day isolation.
- School needs to contact trace students and teachers exposed to Layla in the 48 hours prior to her developing symptoms.



What do you do if Layla sees her doctor and the doctor writes a note saying she has an alternate diagnosis?

- Close Contact
- **Symptoms**

Alternate Diagnosis

- Layla can return to school when she is 24 hours fever free without the use of fever reducing medication and improvement of symptoms.
- Siblings do not need to quarantine.
- School does not need to contact trace.
